LOW STUDENT TO INSTRUCTOR RATIO:

The All-World Hockey Institute prides itself on its high level of intensity and discipline. The camps are designed for the serious student of hockey and personal one on one training and evaluation. The summer program ratio for on ice training will not exceed 5 to 1. We find this maximizes our staff and allows students immediate feedback on skills and abilities.

INNOVATIVE DRILLS AND EUROPEAN CIRCUIT TRAINING:

Players need a challenge in order to improve their skills. Director Rick Hutchinson employs methods of training, video analysis and power skating techniques available. Players will not be bored, standing in line doing the same old drills, rather training in a high tempo, circuit style, that keeps them moving at all times.
